

6 STEPS TO A SAFER RIDE



1. VERIFY BEFORE YOU RIDE

Check the driver's name, photo, license plate, and vehicle details in the app. Never get in a car that doesn't match.



2. SHARE YOUR TRIP

Share your trip details with a friend or family member. Let someone know where you're going.



3. SIT IN THE BACK SEAT

Sit in the back seat whenever possible for more personal space and safety.



4. STAY AWARE

Pay attention to your surroundings and the route. Trust your instincts. If something feels wrong, speak up or end the ride.



5. KEEP YOUR PHONE READY

Keep your phone charged and within reach. Know how to contact 911 if needed.



6. RATE & REPORT

After your trip, rate your driver and report any concerns in the app. Your feedback helps keep the community safe.

Ride share services offer convenience, but staying alert and prepared helps ensure a safe experience for everyone. Use these tips every time you ride.

- ✓ Avoid riding with others you don't know.
- ✓ Don't share personal or financial information.
- ✓ Keep your belongings with you.
- ✓ If you're uncomfortable, end the ride safely and report it.
- ✓ Use in-app safety features.

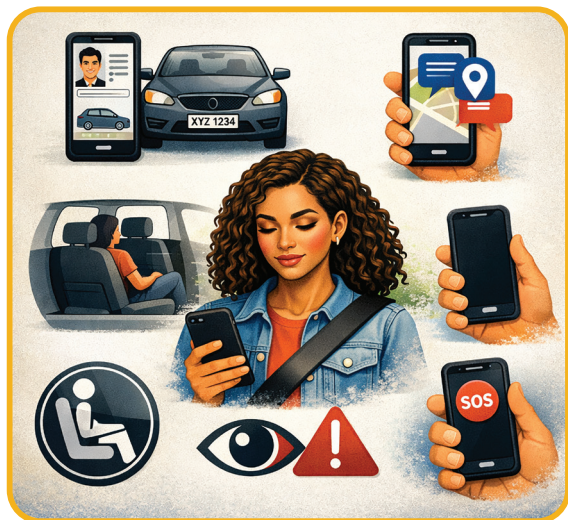

Ride share services are convenient, but your safety depends on the choices you make before, during, and after your ride.

- ☒ Verify your ride and driver.
- ☒ Share your trip.
- ☒ Sit in the back seat.
- ☒ Stay aware of your surroundings.
- ☒ Keep your phone ready.
- ☒ Report concerns.



- ▶ Trust your instincts.
- ▶ End the ride and get out in a safe, well-lit area.
- ▶ Contact 911 if you feel unsafe.

- ▶ Use the official app and confirm your ride details.
- ▶ Verify the driver's name, photo, rating, and license plate.
- ▶ Make sure the vehicle make, model, and color match the app.
- ▶ Share your trip with a trusted friend or family member.
- ▶ Plan your route and check the estimated arrival time.



- Sit in the back seat if possible.
- Wear your seat belt.
- Avoid sharing personal information or your exact destination.
- Stay aware of your surroundings and the route.
- If you feel uncomfortable, ask to end the ride.
- Keep your phone within reach.



- ▶ Check that you have all your belongings.
- ▶ Exit on the sidewalk side of the vehicle.
- ▶ Rate your driver and provide feedback in the app.
- ▶ Report any safety concerns or issues.



If you experience unsafe behavior, report it in the app. In an emergency, call 911. Your report helps keep the community safe.

Avoid discussing personal details like your home address, work, financial information, or travel plans.



Be aware of the area when you are picked up and dropped off. Use well-lit, populated locations when possible.



A charged phone helps you contact 911, your contacts, or the ride share company if needed.



If something feels off at any point, prioritize your safety.



You have the right to ask the driver to follow a different route or end the ride.
